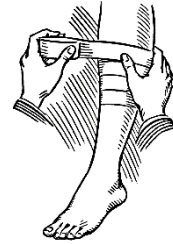

Church Council Meeting 2nd July

People. Alex Laing has been appointed as steward from September by Rev Viv (with authority delegated from GCM).

Youth Worker Members had a wide ranging and frank discussion about this appointment. This included how the lessons learned from the first appointment were to be addressed especially, but not only, through closer liaison with Youth For Christ led by Viv Briney and closer support and mentoring for the worker in which Alex would be involved. Some members believed it would be better to engage a Family Worker and whilst it was agreed that it would be wonderful to have such a worker the grant funding the

church had received was specifically for a youth worker. In a secret ballot the Council agreed (15 votes to 2) to proceed with the interviews & appointment. It was stressed if we are to achieve our mission to young people the support of the whole church would be necessary, both to support the youth strategy team and in being open to new ideas.
