Foyer Building Work

Excitingly, building work will soon be starting in our foyer and will continue through the summer.

The intention is that we will be able to access the building every weekend, and the church itself on Sundays. Open Doors will continue on Saturdays.

Monday Open Doors will also continue, although access may be gained through the kitchen or hall door at the side, and it will be in Room 2.

There may be times when we arrange alternative entrance – look out for any signs. If you need to enter the church when the builders are on site, they are responsible for the safety of everyone in the area, so please speak to them before you walk in.

When having our plans checked for compliance with building regulations, we discovered that we need to improve the fire exits from the church. This will mean that the window to the left of the organ will be replaced by a glass fire exit, with steps outside. The glass will be frosted, which will remove the need for a curtain.

We need to empty the foyer & room 1 before the work starts. We will be doing this after the morning service on 21st Sunday. Any assistance gratefully accepted!
