The idea is that groups would be mixed in such a way as to give us the chance to make new friendships as well as meeting some of our existing friends.

We will need hosts who would provide the garden/ the Zoom, the brewing up and, if necessary, help the conversation along. Alex will give hosts some pointers if they would welcome them.
