Church Council Snippets

Church council met on Wed 22nd July via Zoom.

- 1. Small Group planning is underway and will remain outdoors through the summer.
- 2. We have an *ambition* to re-open in September, for some of our user groups, the small groups and to stream the dial-in service on a Sunday morning. There will be a safety-first approach and all the appropriate risk assessments will be completed before a decision can be made, with support from Circuit, District and the Connexion. Phil Harrison is leading this work, and a further council meeting on 4th August will work on it. This will "feel" very different to before lockdown, and we will need to follow various guidelines.
- 3. It was agreed to extend the contract with YFC for our Youth Worker for another year.
- 4. Our financial situation is extremely difficult. No one should commit to, or spend, any money on behalf of the church without pre-approval from Elspeth. Without the gift day held in February, we would be in the red. The impact of Covid-19 has compounded our already-difficult situation. All possible expenditure has been postponed.
- 5. We have had a very kind offer to pay for a bench to start off our community garden. This work will begin now, in a very low-cost way, using dedicated donations.
