

COVID -19 Secure

- We have carried out a COVID-19 risk assessment and shared the results with the people who work here and use our building.

Getting Ready

There has been a lot of preparation taking place at Central Methodist Church over the last few months to get us ready for re-opening our Church.

Doors will open at 10.15am with the service starting at 10.30am — a "Streamed service" which will then be projected.



Sadly at this moment in time we are not permitted to sing — humming is probably alright but Face masks have to be worn in line with government guidelines. However, If you wish to follow the songs and readings please bring a hymn book and bible.



Social distancing of 2 metres remains in place throughout the premises, and hand sanitizer stations are in place in the main entrance & throughout the church which must be used on entrance and exit.

We have 'fixed' and pre-positioned chairs to achieve the correct social distancing requirements, and the most we can hold in the church will be 20.

So you need to book a place for one of the limited seats, or you will miss out, which we would rather not happen.
