A MESSAGE FROM OUR MINISTER - REV KATHARINE BLAND

Dear Friends,

Let's do something a bit different! After all, it is the start of Advent.

Join with me, and we'll do it together - all of us!

All you need is a pen or a pencil and a piece of paper. And if you've got a yellow or orange or red crayon or a felt-tip pen or coloured pencil, all the better.

Go on then...I'll wait for you.

Right, close your eyes and imagine we're all together. You can be in church or anywhere, God will meet you there, wherever you are.

My dear friend, it's the first Sunday in Advent. It is an opportunity for us to pause a while and reflect. Even if you just have time to stop and sit for only a few minutes, it will do you good. On this first Sunday of Advent, let's reflect on 'Hope'.

The Gospel of John speaks of Christ as the true light coming into the world. In commemoration of that coming, and over the next few weeks, we're going to draw some candles and reflect on the coming of Christ. It is significant that the church has always used that language - the *coming* of Christ - because it speaks to a deep truth. Christ *is* coming. Christ is always coming, always entering a troubled world, a wounded heart.

Don't tell me you can't draw. A candle is easy. It is tall with straight sides with a petal shape on top. Go on, you can do it. Draw your first candle, and then leave room on your paper for four more candles. Your first candle is the candle of hope. As you draw your candle of hope, think of the things you hope for, dare to express your longing for peace, for healing, and the well-being of all creation. And then, when you are ready, here is your prayer. As you read it or say it out loud, know that your voice joins with us all, as one voice...just as if we were all together.

Loving God, as we enter this Advent season, we open all the dark places in our lives and memories to the healing light of Christ. Show us the creative power of hope. Prepare our hearts to be transformed by you, that we may walk in the light of Christ. Amen.
