You have some new first aiders. Those of us pictured below recently attended a First Aid course (courtesy of the Scouts ...thank you).

We learned lots of first aid but also something which may be of interest especially the walkers amongst us. It is how to register your phone so that if you have to ting the emergency services they can immediately see your exact location without you having to tell them.

Text the word "register" to 112 (the UK and international emergency number)

- 1. You will receive a message to read. (Don't skip this stage as the service wants you to read it so will not allow you to move on too soon.)
- 2. If happy just reply "yes" by text (confusingly it says text to 999 but just reply to the message).
- 3. Then you will get confirmation of your registration.

Simple as that!

Gift Day – Sunday 10th July

Carol Sherratt has made a great start as our treasurer and is fast getting to grips with it all. I don't think it will come as a surprise to you that we are not in a secure financial position. The "golden rule" is that our giving should at least cover the quarterly assessment, which pays for our ministers, manses etc. This is £3567 per month. Our current giving (including gift aid) stands at £3277 per month, leaving a monthly deficit of £290 per month. In addition, we have our running costs - which are currently £4000 more per year than our income from lettings.

We have identified July 10th as an ideal opportunity to hold a gift day, when Carol will provide further details of our financial position, but please give the matter some thought, and if you can increase your giving, do feel free to do so as soon as you are able!
