Data Protection Information

It is a long time since the new law on the protection of personal data was introduced (GDPR). You may remember that at the time we got a lot of information about the records that the church holds and our rights under the new law.

We are currently conducting our annual review of our arrangements for making sure that any information CMC holds is held legitimately, is accurate, is no more detailed than it needs to be and that it is kept absolutely securely.

The information held will depend on your relationship with the church. It could be a simple record of your name or your name and contact details. It could, however, be more detailed information, depending on any role you hold, such as whether you have attended any training or had a criminal record check.

I seems timely just to remind you that we do hold such information and to assure you that we keep it safe.

For those who are interested, we would draw your attention to the **Privacy Notice** of the Methodist Church. This explains how Churches, Circuits and Districts collect, use and protect your personal information and your rights in this regard. You can find it:
