
Affirming Christianity

You will have heard that a new NWE District will come into being on 1st September this year replacing the existing Bolton & Rochdale, Cumbria, Lancashire, Liverpool and Manchester & Stockport Districts. Linda has circulated by Google email information from the District Office offering opportunities for people to think about volunteering to fill a wide range of roles in the new District structure which will be set up - the existing organisations will not simply be joined together. There are 4 items for your attention:
