'Posada' - Churches Together Advent 2025

Churches Together will be doing something different and rather special this year to mark the season of Advent. Posada (Spanish for 'inn') is a lovely tradition, originating in Mexico, in which Mary and Joseph are symbolically welcomed into peoples lives for a night.

Mary and Joseph, in the form of Russian dolls, will be hosted by a household for one night and then passed to another family or gathering of people. They will be accompanied by a folder which explains the tradition, and contains prayers which can be used, pictures to colour in, and space for people to write down what they do and what it means to them.

Our two churches will host Mary and Joseph during the week beginning Sunday 14th December. Hosts are already signed up, including Gilbert Court and Holcroft Grange, where Mary and Joseph will be part of our Christmas service on 18th December.

The event will start on the **first Sunday in Advent, 30th November**, at 4.00pm on the forecourt of Newchurch Rectory on Jackson Avenue. There will be refreshments - each church will bring mince pies. It will end at the same time and venue on Christmas Eve when Mary and Joseph will be taken to Newchurch Parish Church.
