#### **Catering at Culcheth Methodist Church**

This is an appeal to everyone prepared to help at CMC in the provision of simple refreshments, those who cook for us and those who run the kitchen when we have larger events such as the Christmas Fair, Simple Lunches, 3 Towns etc. As you appreciate it is essential that we operate as safely as possible. In addition our kitchen is registered with the Local Authority as a food business and this brings additional requirements.

There is a very small band of CMC people who have undertaken certificated Food Hygiene Training and their 3 year renewal date is September this year. Even if all of these refreshed their training we would still need significantly more trained people to operate safely. So if you ever run an event using the kitchen, help with Open Doors, Tuesday Tots, Sunday tea etc. or do any baking or cooking at home to share at church or are happy to do in the future, **PLEASE** will you consider attending the training. It is likely to be a 2-3 hour face to face session at the end of August/beginning September (in conjunction with other churches in the circuit). We may also try to find a course that can be done electronically at home. Please will you let me know as soon as possible if you can help CMC in this way.
